<b>Course Objectives</b>	To ensure that delegates have a thorough knowledge of the hazards in their workplace. To give a basic understanding of ergonomics in their workplace. To be able to identify those hazards which will most likely cause to harm them To ensure they understand the need to report dangerous situations, and to ensure they understand their responsibilities under H&S Law To understand the need for Health & Safety Law and to understand why they need to comply.
